

Incorporated as a not-for-profit institution in 1985, its mission is to foster the development of highquality contemporary dance programming and expand the dance audience in the Kansas City metropolitan region. City in Motion builds bridges in the community with its professional modern dance company, school of dance, outreach program, and performance series that includes "Dance in the Park" and "Modern Night". The critically acclaimed company is made up of eight professional dancers who demonstrate remarkable chemistry on stage. Under the artistic co-direction of Tracie Jensen, Ann Shaughnessy and Bobbi Foudree, an environment is created that supports the evolution of original and unique dance pieces that appeal to an expanding audience base.




